**Under this agreement for 2017
Leichhardt State School will receive**

\$179,200

This funding will be used to

- Improve student literacy levels focussing on oral language, phonemic, phonological awareness and vocabulary. Increases will be evidenced by:
 - 10% improvement in NAPLAN Literacy in Year 3 and 5 Upper Two Bands (U2B).
 - > 60% of students reading at home with a target of 90% of eligible students gaining 2 reading levels each term.
 - Improve student Early Start results by 20% in Year P-2.

Our initiatives include

- Providing extension for students in U2B and those with potential to be in U2B.
- Building parental knowledge (social capital) and commitment to reading with their child at home.
- Developing oral language skills of P-2 students including introduction of Age Appropriate Pedagogies in Prep.
- Building vocabulary knowledge of all students in the school through explicit "Narrative Blasts".

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Employing two part-time (Junior and Senior) Heads of Curriculum Student Services for two days each. | \$ 81 041 |
| • Providing additional teacher aide intervention time and reading support in every classroom. | \$ 88 159 |
| • Provide release time for teachers to collect Early Start data. | \$ 10 000 |
| Total | \$179 200 |
